Pastoral Reflections:

A few years ago there was a kind of renewal campaign in the United Methodist church called "Rethink Church". The idea was that in a new time and age the church needed to think about new ways to be in mission and ministry to the world. We needed to be audacious and creative... fearless and faithful. New ideas are great if they provide new and authentic ways to engage our neighbors and the world with the "good news" but if its only ideas and no action then what are we really accomplishing. We don't just need to rethink church but to redo church.

But if by redoing church we think its just about doing things differently from 10:30-11:30 on Sunday morning, then we've probably got the wrong idea of church. Getting people to attend a church service, unfortunately, seems to be the primary goal of many churches. Get people into the doors and into the pews for an hour a week. I cannot recall any place in the gospels where Jesus told anyone to go to church. There is no campaign in Paul the Apostle 's ministry that was getting people into the church building or a service. There weren't church buildings at the time and there really wasn't even the bible as we know it. So perhaps what we need to do in order to redo church in this time is to look back to see what the church was about as it began and grew in the power of the Spirit.

Acts 2:42ff is a favorite for the way it encapsulates to life of the early church. There were groups of followers of the Way meeting in each others' homes. They broke bread together and learned together about the teachings of Jesus. They shared life and their possessions with each other and those in need. The gatherings were marked by great joy and sense of awe. They continued to heal and teach the "good news". It was a very simple existence with none of the paraphernalia that we have identified as essential for being and doing church. It was not so much an institution as it was a movement. It was Spirit directed. Church was not a meeting or activity you went to (though they did meet often) but a kind of life you did and lived with others who also desired to follow in Jesus' way of love and justice.

Is it time to not just rethink church but to redo church? Is it time to sense the Spirit of God blowing new life and in new ways? is now the time to entrust our future to God? To look to the future is to also look backwards at the example, teachings and witness of Jesus and the early church- to rediscover that all we need has been given to us and that Jesus is in our midst. Is God calling us to not just rethink but to also redo church
